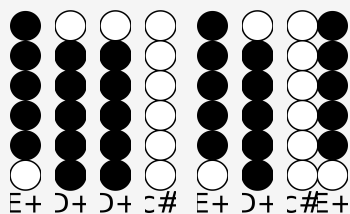
Your faith was strong but you needed proof

 Hallelujah, hallelujah



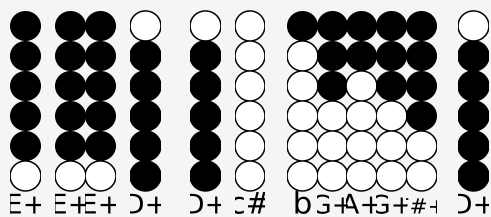
Hallelujah, hal-le lu- jah
