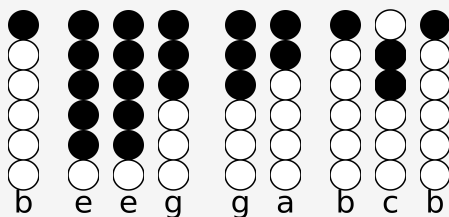
Me mo-ther kept a board-ing house,



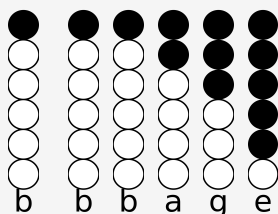
Hul-la-ba-loo be-lay
