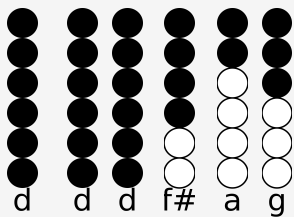
One day as I ram-bled



down by the sea-shore

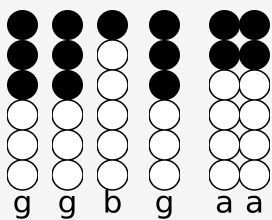


The wind it did whis-tle,

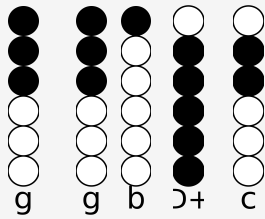


and the wa-ters did roar

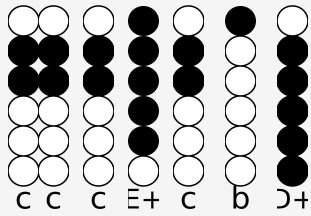
I heard a fair dam-sel

in the wa-ters a-round



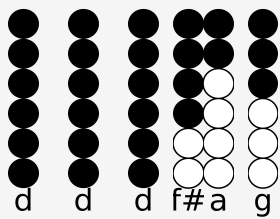
I nev-er will mar-ry,
