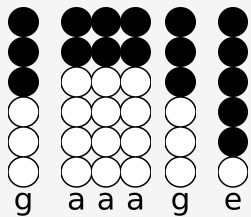
As I went up to Darby's town



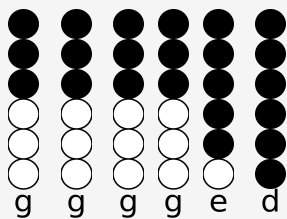
T'see what I could see



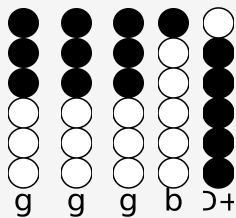
I saw the biggest, fattest ram



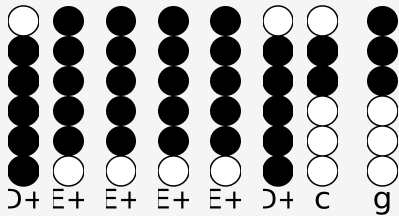
(That)was ever fed on hay



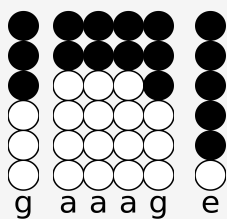
Filla my Darby ram, sir
