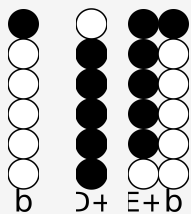
the summer wind,came blowin` in



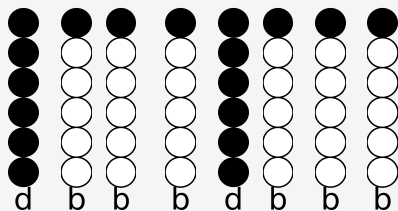
across the sea



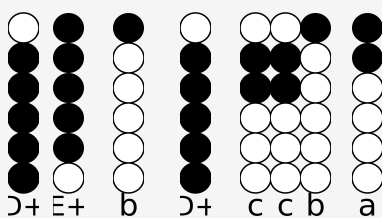
it lingered there,so warm and fair

b e n e a t h t h e b r i g h t b l u e u m b r e l l a s k y

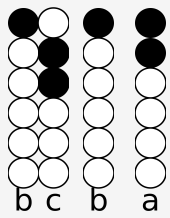
beneath the bright blue umbrella sky

t h e n s o f t e r t h a n t h a t p i p e r m a n

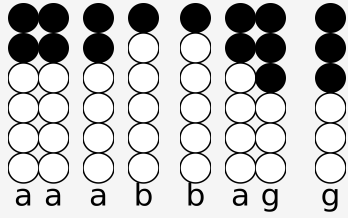
then softer than that piper man
