like I knew she would.

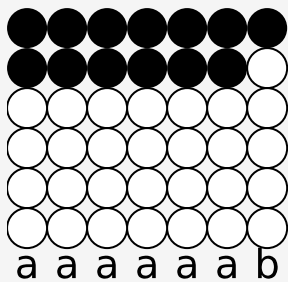

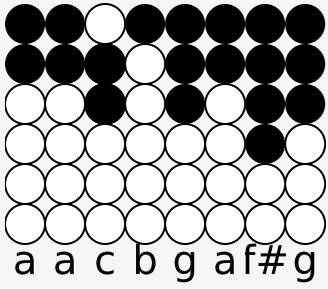

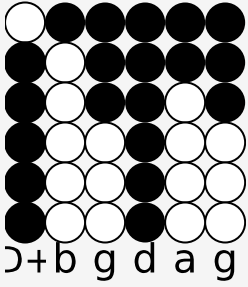
