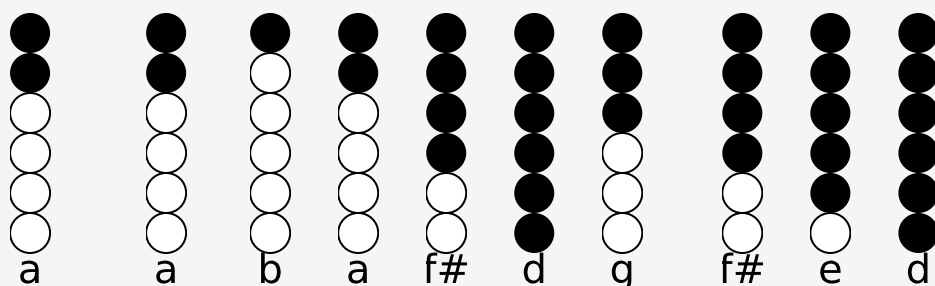
I have walked 'cross the sand on the Grand Banks of New-found-land,



Lazed on the ridge of the Mir-a-mi-chi.

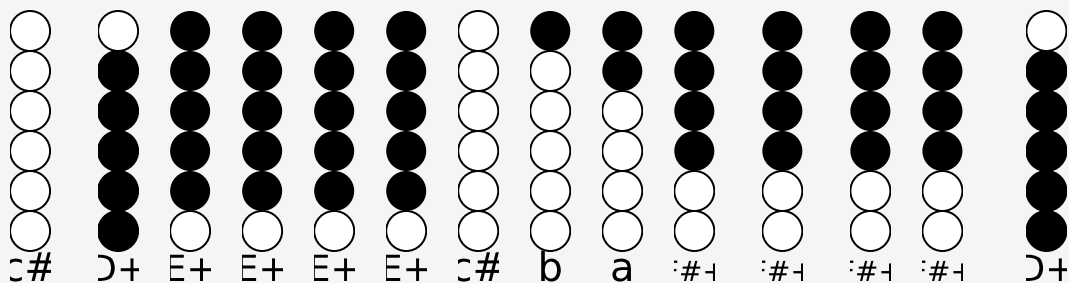


Seen the waves tear and roar at the stone coast of Lab-ra-dor,

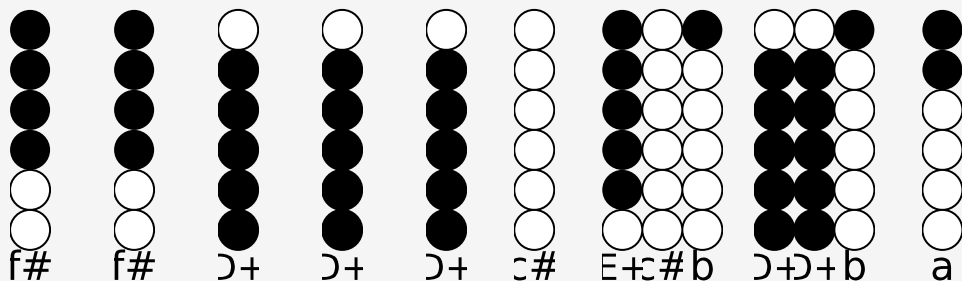


Watched them roll back to the great north-ern sea.

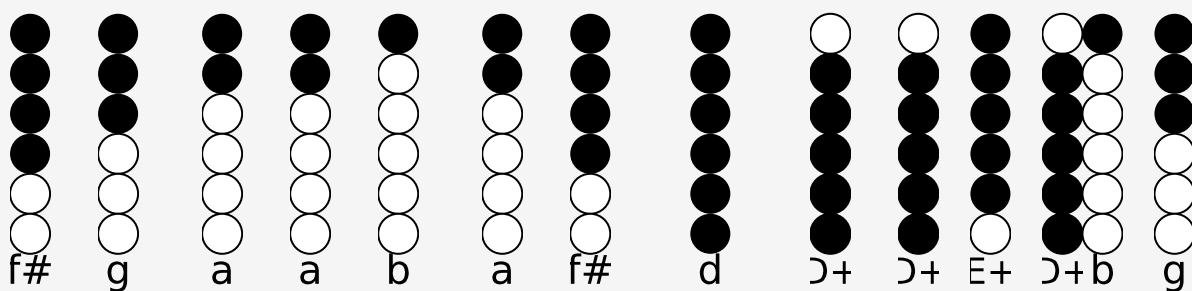

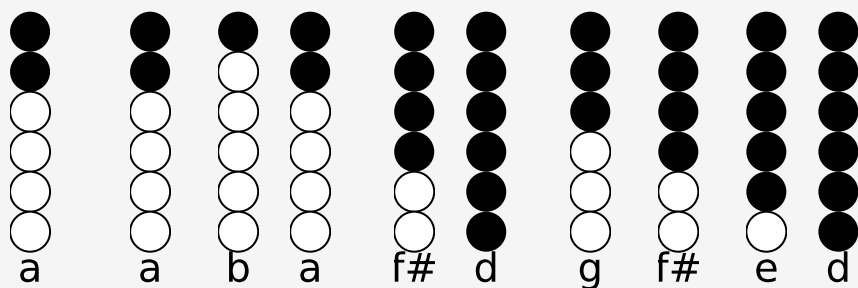
From the Van-cou-ver Is-land to the Al-bert-a High-land,
