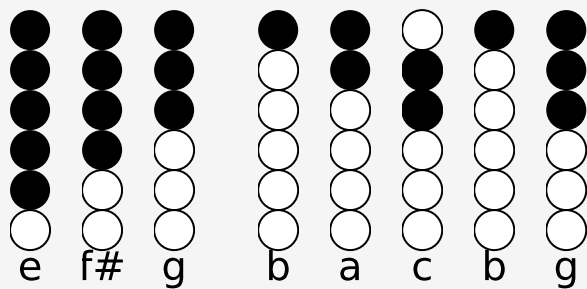

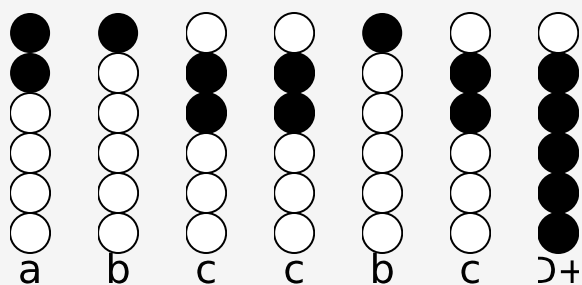
There's a track win-ding back,



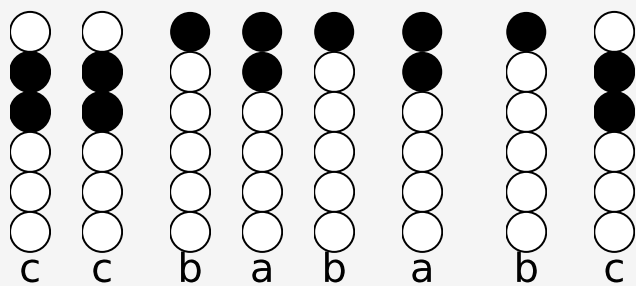

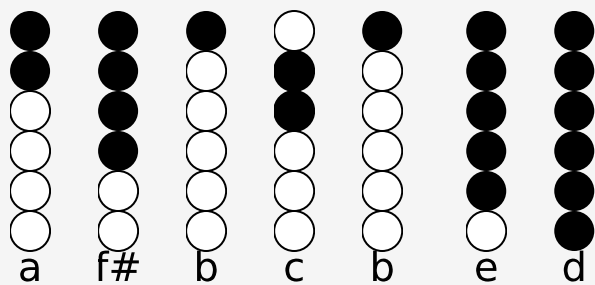

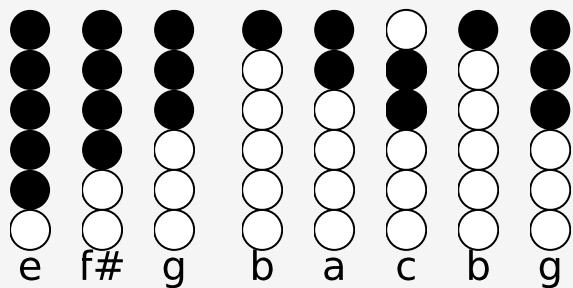
